We recognise our responsibility to minimise our environmental footprint and operate in a sustainable manner for the benefit of our planet, our community, and future generations. Our commitment goes beyond simply complying with legal requirements; we strive for continuous improvement and innovation in every aspect of our business.

This policy outlines our proactive approach to managing environmental risks and opportunities.

Our Core Environmental Principles and Objectives

Waste Management and Efficiency

We are dedicated to reducing waste at its source and maximising resource efficiency. Our goal is to decrease our total operational waste by **15% annually** over the next three years.

To achieve this, we will:

- Implement a comprehensive recycling programme for common materials, including paper, cardboard, steel, aggregates, cables, and plastics, on all job sites and in our offices.
- Digitalise project documentation, invoicing, and internal communication to become a paperless company by 2027.
- Work with suppliers to reduce packaging waste from materials and components.
- Minimise waste by evaluating operations and ensuring they are as efficient as possible.
- Actively promote recycling both internally and amongst its customers, staff and suppliers.
- Source and promote a product range to minimise the environmental impact of both production and distribution.
- Meet or exceed all the environmental legislation that relates to the Company.
- Avoid the use of hazardous materials where practical and source alternative products.
- Continually improve and reduce environmental impacts.

Carbon Emissions and Energy

We are committed to reducing our carbon footprint through smarter travel and energy consumption. Our objective is to reduce our fleet's carbon emissions by **20% by 2030**. This will be achieved by:

 Optimising travel routes using fleet management software to reduce mileage and fuel consumption.



- Prioritising virtual meetings and teleconferencing to eliminate non-essential business travel.
- Reduce the need to travel, restricting to necessity trips only.
- Favour 'green' vehicles and maintain them rigorously to ensure ongoing efficiency.
- Use local labour and materials where available to reduce CO2 and help the community.

Sustainable Sourcing and Supply Chain

We will actively seek out and promote sustainable products and materials to minimise the environmental impact of our supply chain. Our goals are to:

- Increase our use of locally sourced materials to 50% by 2027, supporting the local economy and reducing transportation emissions.
- Avoid the use of hazardous materials, actively seeking out and using environmentally friendly alternatives where available.
- Only use licensed and appropriate organisations to dispose of waste.

Compliance and Continuous Improvement

We will meet or exceed all relevant environmental legislation and regulations. This policy will be reviewed and updated **annually**, and we will set new, challenging targets to ensure we are continually improving our environmental performance. We are prepared to handle any potential environmental incidents through a robust emergency response plan.

Employee and Stakeholder Engagement

We will:

- Provide regular environmental training and promote awareness to ensure all staff understand their role in achieving our goals.
- Engage with staff to gather ideas and feedback on our environmental initiatives.

- Review and update this policy at least once annually
